

L'ANSE TOWNSHIP PROPERTY OWNERS

The township will be visiting your property to update Township records in order to comply with Michigan Department of Treasury regulations.

Starting on or before June 1, 2011, a two-person team, working for L'Anse Township, will be visiting your property to measure all structures, interview the owner of the property and take photographs.

The teams working for L'Anse Township will carry photo ID cards. The team will first knock on your door to see if anyone is at home, and ask for permission to examine your property. The team will ask the property owner some basic questions regarding the property to ensure a complete record of your property. The team will then measure all structures and take photographs of the property.

If no one is at home at the time of the visit, a door hanger questionnaire will be left for you to fill out and the team will measure and photograph your property. It is requested you complete the questionnaire so the Township will have accurate information about your property. By providing the requested information, it will insure an accurate and uniform assessment of all properties in the Township.

THE TEAMS WILL NOT HAVE TO ENTER YOUR HOME FOR AN INTERIOR INSPECTION. THE UPDATE WILL BE AN EXTERNAL INSPECTION ONLY.

If you do not wish to allow the team on your property, please inform them promptly. The team will then ask you to sign a statement that you have refused the Township access to your property. If the Township is refused access to your property, we will estimate the value of your property.
